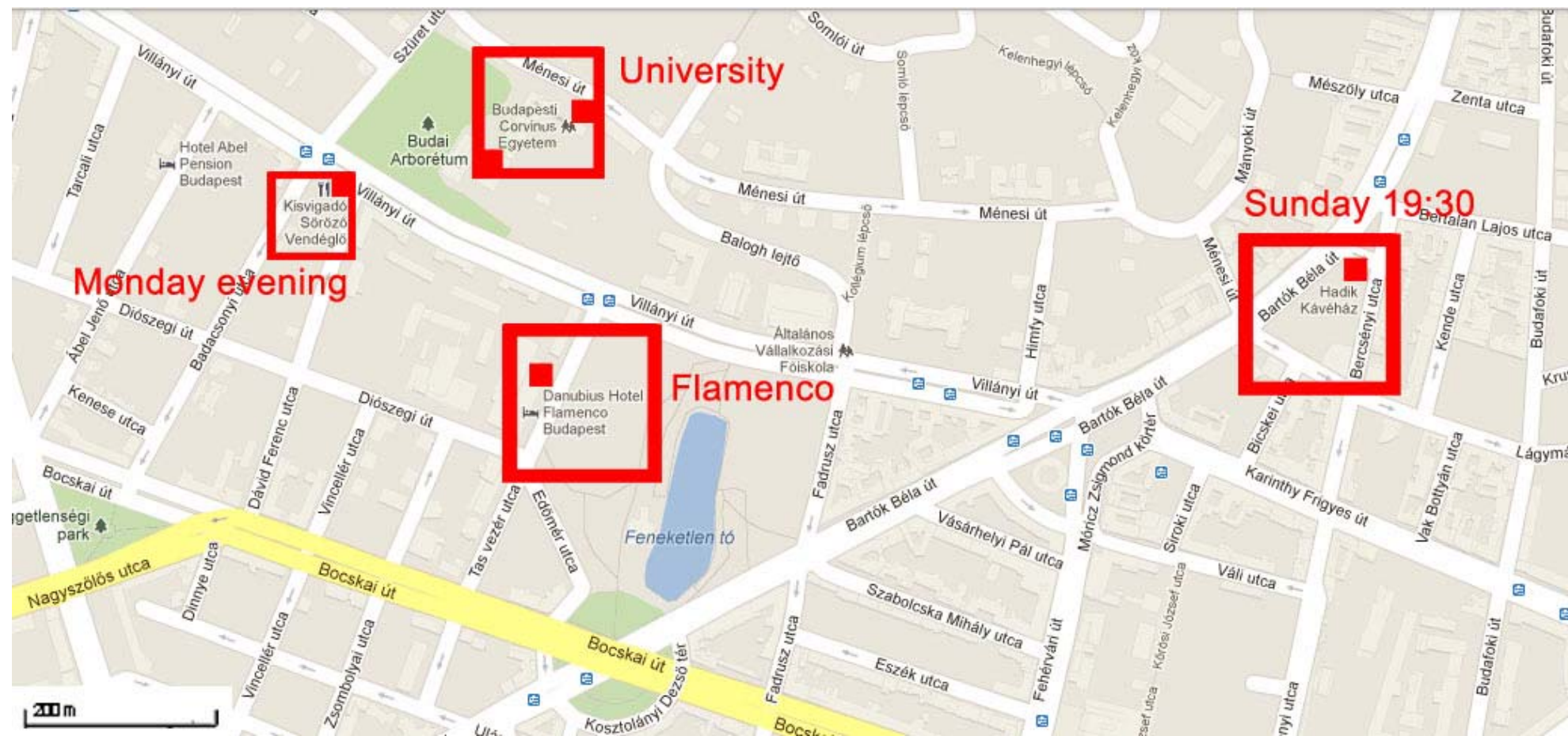

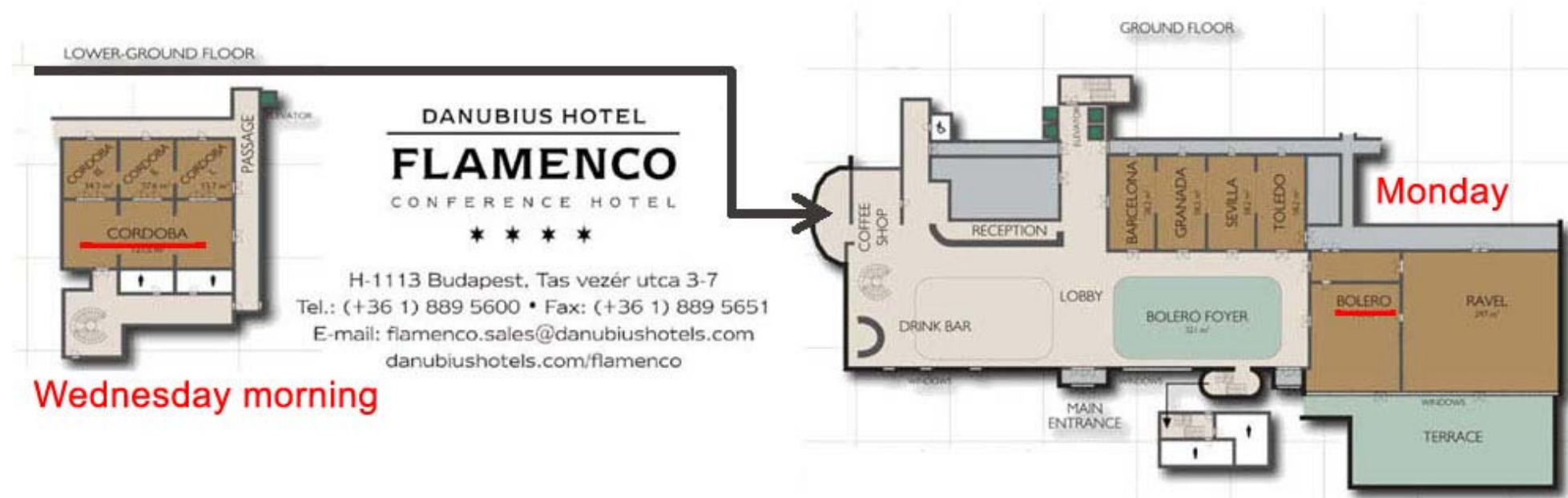

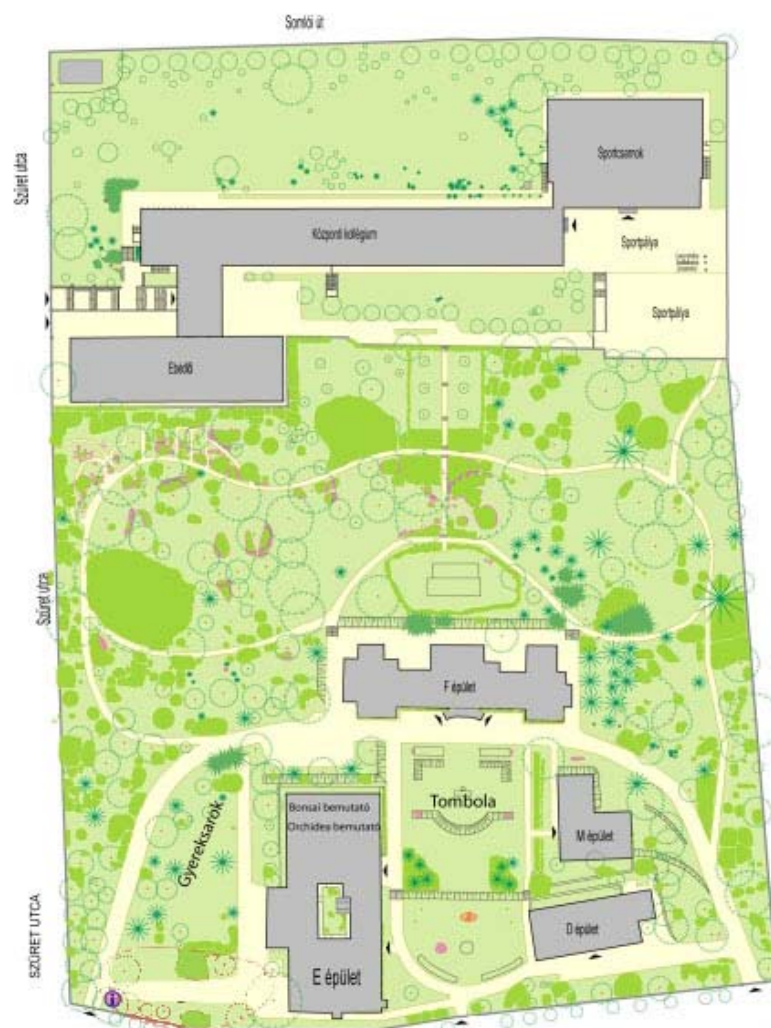

Most important locations, meeting points in Budapest (District XI.)



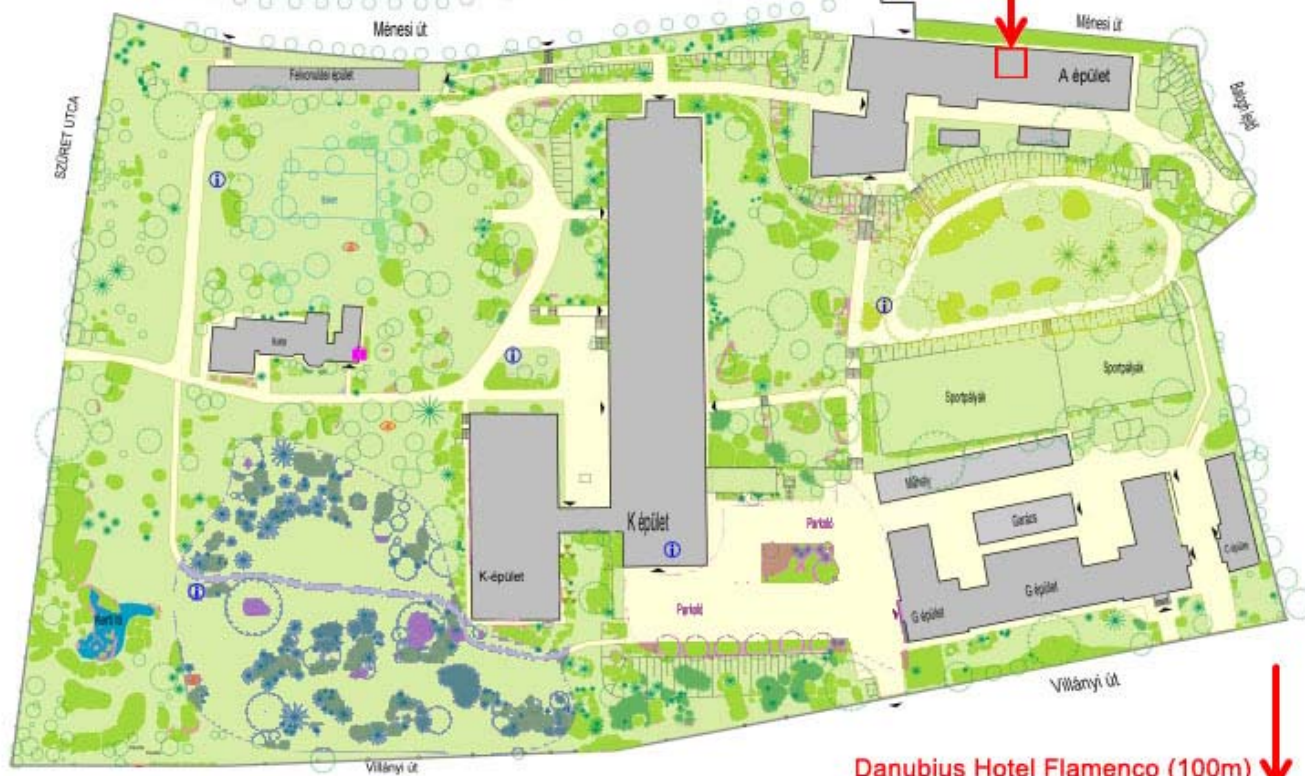
Meeting rooms in Danubius Hotel Flamenco
